Year 5 EOTC trip to Rangitoto Island

Dear Parents and Caregivers

On **Thursday 17 November** the Year 5 students will be going on a trip to Rangitoto Island. Your child will need to be at school **by 8:45 am** as the bus will leave for the ferry terminal promptly at **9:00 am**. Please make sure your child is at school on time as the ferry won't wait for us. We will return to school at approximately **4:30 pm**. Please make sure there is an adult to collect your child from school at this time.

Students need to adhere to the following conditions:

- They **must** wear school uniform and bring a raincoat with a hood, good walking shoes (no jandals), sun cream and a hat.
- Belongings **must** be placed inside a bag which can be zipped up and carried on their back e.g. a backpack.
- They must bring morning tea, a large packed lunch and a big bottle of drinking water.
- Please make sure your child has adequate food and water for the day as there are no shops on Rangitoto Island.

A permission slip is not required as you have given permission for curriculum-based trips at the time of enrolment. We are going to need a few parent helpers for this trip. Please only complete the form below if you are available and would like to help. Please note: there will be a lot of walking involved during the day and we are unable to take younger siblings with us.

The cost of the trip has been covered by the Government Donation Scheme so there is no cost for your child to attend. Please return the **parent helpers form** to the office by **Friday 4th November** and I will be in contact with all parent helpers prior to the trip.
